The agreements between our firm and Guozi Shudian are oral agreements between our representatives and theirs. They offer wholesale distributors discounts to our firm, as national U.S. importer and distributor of their publications and products. Our payments are made to them through the National Bank of Pakistan in New York City, on the exact invoice price of items as billed and received, due in six months from receipt of shipments. Guozi Shudian offers us credits to defray 50% of our advertising expenses for publications we import and distribute from them and sends us occasionally sample copies of periodicals in surplus for our use, and also catalogs without charge. On business trips to China, our representatives are offered expense-free arrangements. There is no "duration" period for these verbal agreements.

4. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.


5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

We are engaged in the importation, wholesale and retail distribution and promotion of books, periodicals, records, posters and pictures from Guozi Shudian from our three stores at: 2929 24th St., San Francisco, CA 94110; 125 5th Avenue, New York, N.Y. 10003; and 900 W. Armitage Avenue, Chicago, IL 60614.
