Martin and Company has handled public relations and promotional activities of the European Travel Commission, usually by authority of a letter of agreement pertaining to specific projects. At the present time there is no formal contract or correspondence between the parties.

At its meeting of October 29, 1969, in Dublin, the European Travel Commission agreed to pay \$8,000 to Donald N. Martin and Company for secretarial and clerical services for the year 1970. Public relations activities designed to promote U.S. travel to member countries of the Commission; promotion of Europe's tourist attractions; liaison with the travel industry.
