



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Dear Mr. de Cabrol:

Both Norman and I were delighted to receive the good news on Monday that Ruder & Finn will be representing the Aeroport de Paris for your program in the United States next spring. This letter will confirm our agreement and outline a general timetable for the program.

Ruder & Finn will organize four luncheons for the Aeroport de Paris in New York, Chicago, Dallas, and Los Angeles. We suggest that they be held on four consecutive days, Monday through Thursday, during the week of May 19, June 2 or June 9. Monday, May 26 is our Memorial Day holiday so we have to eliminate that week from consideration.

It is important that we begin our research on the guest lists four months in advance of the luncheon dates so that invitations can be mailed in all four locations three weeks prior to the events. If you decide to hold the luncheons during the week of May 19, for example, we should begin in mid-January. I suggest that the luncheon in New York be held on Monday, in Chicago on Tuesday, in Dallas on Wednesday and in Los Angeles on Thursday, because we would like to hold an overall briefing session in New York on the Friday before the luncheons. If you prefer a West to East routing, however, we could arrange it.

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At the briefing session, we will acquaint the executives from Paris with the general program of the luncheons, review speeches and the presentation, and inform them of important details and personalities in each city. In addition, there will be local briefings before each event.

Ruder & Finn branches will handle all arrangements for luncheons in their cities. They will also assist our New York research division with lists of local industry groups, advise us on possible co-sponsors and local dignitaries, contact the press, and do necessary follow-up telephoning and mailings before and after the luncheons.


Ruder & Finn New York will prepare speeches and an information kit for distribution at the luncheon and to the press. The kit will include a press release on the main topics presented in your speeches, background information on the Aeroport de Paris, biographies of visiting officers, and any brochures which you feel are appropriate. Releases will be localized in each city.

I think that I have covered very generally most of the details. I am enclosing a timetable and a revised budget. Our fee for the work will be \$25,000 to be billed in five monthly installments of \$5,000 each beginning February 1 or when we formally begin our work for you. Expenses will be billed as they are incurred.

I have notified our branch offices in Chicago, Dallas and Los Angeles that you have decided to go ahead with the program. We are all looking forward to working with you.
