
CONTRACT

1. The City of Hamburg has retained Ruder Finn Arts & Communications Counselors (RF A&CC) as its public relations counsel effective January 1, 2007 through March 31, 2007.
2. Public relations services to be provided by RF A&CC include: planning and implementing a press briefing on March 28, 2007 in New York to publicize the Elbe Philharmonic Hall, Hamburg. (See event scenario dated December 11, 2006.)
3. As compensation for its services on this project, RF A&CC will be paid a fee of \$45,000. Of the \$45,000 paid to RF A&CC, \$15,000 will be paid to M.L. Falcone Public Relations (MLF PR) for the company's collaboration in the planning and implementation of the event. RF A&CC will bill the City of Hamburg \$25,000 on January 1, 2007 and the remaining \$20,000 on February 1, 2007. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice.
4. Out-of-pocket disbursements for, on behalf of, or for the benefit of the City of Hamburg will be billed at cost at the end of each month. These include production expenses such as invitations, releases and mailings, photos and prints, artwork, and printing, as well as travel, telephone, courier and business meals. We may bill you in advance for approved major out-of-pocket expenses. RF A&CC will obtain advance approval from the City of Hamburg before incurring any expense over \$500.00.
5. In the event the City of Hamburg questions the validity of a charge, payment for only that portion under question may be delayed without a finance charge, provided that the City of Hamburg expresses its objection in writing within twenty (20) days of the date of the invoice.
6. RF A&CC will maintain accurate records of all out-of-pocket expenditures made on behalf of the City of Hamburg. RF A&CC will be prepared to supply, during normal business hours and at reasonable intervals, supporting documentation required by the City of Hamburg with the exception of the following: travel and miscellaneous expenses under \$50.00, postage, photocopy, telecopy, telephone and messenger service.
7. If, as an agent, RF A&CC places paid media advertising for the City of Hamburg, media and production costs must be paid to RF A&CC by the City of Hamburg.


8. A finance charge of 1.5% per month will be assessed on outstanding balances over 30 days.
9. RF A&CC and the City of Hamburg shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the other party and its officers, directors, employees, subcontractors and agents from and against all claims, liability, loss and expense, including reasonable costs, collection expenses, attorney's fees, and court costs which may arise because of the sole negligence, misconduct, or other fault of the indemnifying party, its officers, directors, employees, subcontractors or agents in performance of its obligations under the agreement. This indemnification shall survive the termination of this agreement.
10. The City of Hamburg acknowledges that it has read this agreement between the parties, which supersedes all proposals or prior agreements, oral or written, and all other communications between the parties relating to the subject matter of this agreement. This agreement may be amended only in writing, signed by both parties hereto.
11. This agreement can be canceled by either party on ninety (90) days advance notice in writing.
12. All representatives of Ruder Finn shall keep confidential all information concerning the City of Hamburg that Ruder Finn obtains during work performed under this Agreement.
