

These offices provide information relating to the Japanese economy and business as well as U.S.-Japan economic and trade relations and engage in various activities to promote trade and direct investment between Japan and the United States. JETRO offices in the United States are believed to serve similar functions as those of the United States Trade Center (of the United States Department of Commerce) established in Japan.

As the New York-based office of JETRO, JETRO New York provides to public officials, corporations, associations, individuals and any other interested parties information and materials relating to various aspects of Japanese economy and business as well as U.S.-Japanese economic and trade relations. JETRO New York also monitors the development of U.S. economic and market conditions for JETRO.
