The Registrant has agreed to provide legal representation before the Tariff Commission by presenting witnesses and arguments during a Tariff Commission hearing. It has also agreed to attempt to persuade various persons that the President should not extend the current tariff levels on certain carpetings.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The Registrant provided legal representation of the foreign principal before the Tariff Commission in its Investigation No. TEA-I-EX-5 by presenting witnesses and argument at a Tariff Commission hearing and by filing a brief with the Tariff Commission. The Registrant also represents the foreign principal in discussions with, or in sending information to, various Congressional and Executive Branch officials and representatives of foreign governments and organizations with respect to the President's decision whether to extend the current tariff level on certain floor coverings.

6. Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act? <sup>1/</sup> Yes  No

The Registrant has agreed to represent the foreign principal and a group of American importers before the Tariff Commission in its Investigation No. TEA-I-EX-5 concerning the tariff levels on certain floor coverings and in relation to the President's decision on whether to extend the current tariff level. The fee for such representation is to be determined at a future date but will range from \$20,000 to \$30,000 plus out-of-pocket expenses. The foreign principal will pay half of the Registrant's fee. The representation will endure until the President decides whether to extend the tariff level or January 1, 1970, whichever occurs first.
