The Registrant provided legal representation of the foreign principal before the Tariff Commission in its Investigation No. 332-64. The Registrant advises the foreign principal on U.S. laws, regulations and policies affecting the importations of cheese, and will engage in other activities as required in legal representation of the principal.

The Registrant has agreed to represent the Swiss Cheese Union, Inc. and the Switzerland Gruyere Processed Cheese Manufacturers' Association with respect to the importation of cheeses from Switzerland into the U.S. The fee for such representation is to be determined periodically, based on the usual criteria for legal fees plus out-of-pocket expenses, and is to be paid by the Swiss Cheese Union, Inc. The duration of the agreement is indefinite.
