The mandate given to the new Department of International Affairs to "act as an agent" of the Québec Government or to represent the Québec Government has been confirmed by the Bill of Law No-42 of the National Assembly of Québec on November 10, 1988.

- Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

The Department of International Affairs is a new Department formed by the fusion of two former departments, the Department of International Relations and the Department of External Trade and Technological Development. The mandate of the new department of International Affairs is to coordinate the activities of all Québec Government agencies or departments outside Québec and to officially represent the Québec Government. This mandate has been confirmed by the Bill of Law No-42 of the "Assemblée Nationale du Québec", ratified on November 10, 1988.

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5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The activities we engage in on behalf of the Québec Government are identical to the activities we have engaged in under the previous department of "Relations internationales" as described in our previous reports:

- Officially represents the Government of Québec, its departments and affiliated organizations;
- establishes and maintains close ties between the people of Québec and their American neighbors, with a view to promoting business, financial and cultural contacts on a mutual basis;
- promotes two-way trade between Québec and the United States as a whole, and assists American Industries in manufacturing their products in Québec;
- promotes the tourist industry in the United States;
- selects candidates for immigration to Québec.
