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

Synopsis of film: A sensitively portrayed film of the plight of the African refugees and the attempt by the United Nations, High Commissioner for Refugees to alleviate their plight and rehabilitate and re-establish them in new lands or repatriate them wherever possible.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.


Registrant will provide distribution of this foreign principal's film to broadcast television, educational television and cable television systems throughout the United States for a total of 4 national network cablecasts to 427 cable systems and an additional 100 cable systems will program the film twice during 1983. All necessary arrangements and services will be provided for the conversion of the motion picture to the proper electronic format for satellite transmission (3/4" U-matic tape).

Distribution rates - Television (broadcast): \$40/booking; (cable) \$25/booking. In addition to print procurement, the distribution activity will be reported monthly on certification reports and the necessary promotion and print maintenance will be provided.

Total distribution budget for 1983 - \$18,250.

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Dear Mr. Devico:

This is to confirm our agreement for the distribution and print procurement of the new motion picture SANCTUARY: AN AFRICAN EPIC. The distribution will be limited to broadcast television, educational television and cable television systems throughout the United States of America.

We will include the new film in our Modern Satellite/Modern Cable Network program for 1983 which will permit four (4) national network cablecasts to 427 cable systems which represent approximately 6.5 million American homes. Further an additional 100 cable systems will program the new film twice during 1983 and these 100 represent approximately 2.7 million additional American homes.

Our charges for individual television bookings which are based on signed reports recovered from television and cable systems will be at the rate of \$40 per television booking and \$25 per cable booking. This activity will be reported monthly and of course is included in the invoice as indicated. We will provide the necessary promotion, print maintenance and provide you with monthly reports of distribution activity.

An itemized invoice in the amount of \$18,250 is enclosed which will cover the procurement of 25 16mm prints, 10 3/4" U-matic videocassettes, and all distribution fees for 1983.

If this, along with a copy of our general terms, meets with your approval, would you kindly sign a copy of this letter and return it to me.

We look forward to working with you in the marketing and distribution of your motion pictures to American audiences.
