The registrant will arrange to transmit a series of programs, on 3/4" NTSC tape, titled "Scandinavian Weekly Magazine" via Modern Satellite Network, RCA SATCOM 3R, to a network of approximately 569 affiliates serving more than 10 million subscribers. The programs range from 30 - 59 minutes in length and two programs are presently scheduled for airing on 2/8 and 2/15/85 and 3/8/85, 12:30-1 pm and 12:00-1 pm, respectively. Others will be aired throughout 1985 - particular dates have not yet been scheduled. Rates: \$1,200/hr. \$750/1/2 hr. payment in advance. The proposed contract term will be for 52 weeks starting January 1, 1985, with an option to renew.


Description of programs: Review of Scandinavia, including culture, cooking, history, folklore and its people.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

Registrant will provide distribution of this foreign principal's series titled "Scandinavian Weekly Magazine" on 3/4 NTSC tape, to cable systems affiliated with Modern Satellite Network throughout the United States. Each program will be listed in a monthly program guide and periodic usage reports will be provided.

Gentlemen:

This will confirm our agreement to program your Scandinavian Weekly television series via Modern Satellite Network for the year 1985. We propose the following:

1. MSN The Information Channel will transmit the Scandinavian Weekly program via satellite, RCA SATCOM 3R. You will provide us with a 3/4" NTSC tape of each program.
2. Distribution will be to our network of approximately 569 affiliates serving more than 10 million subscribers as of this date.
3. We will list your weekly show in our program guide on a monthly basis.
4. We will provide you with periodic reports of cable systems affiliated with MSN.
5. The contract term will be for 52 weeks, starting January 1, 1985, with an option to renew.
6. We will program your show at the same day of the week.
7. The rate for these services will be:
\$1200 per hour/\$750 per 1/2 hour. Payment will be made monthly in advance.
8. Program information will be provided by you in advance for the purpose of publicity. We require show cue sheets with timing of segments, commercials and breaks. Further, you will provide us at least four (4) days in advance with tapes for the weekly shows.
