Thank you for retaining Patton Boggs, LLP to represent American Worldwide Inc. (AWI) on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Angola. Particularly, Patton Boggs will assist with respect to Angola's comprehensive public affairs efforts to better its overall relations with the United States.

To ensure that AWI and we have a common understanding of the terms of our representation and to comply with the rules of professional conduct for the jurisdictions in which we practice, I have enclosed a statement describing the standard terms of engagement for legal services to be provided by Patton Boggs, LLP. The terms of engagement cover such matters as our procedure for handling potential conflicts of interest, fees, costs and expenses, billing arrangements and terms of payment. Please review the document carefully to ensure that it comports with your understanding. This letter supplements and modifies the enclosed terms of engagement.

Thomas H. Boggs, Jr. and I will be primarily responsible for the oversight of work done on behalf of Angola and will supervise the lawyers and other professionals who may work on this project. I anticipate that associates, staff attorneys, legal assistants, specialists and/or in-house consultants will assist in the matter.

The fees for our work will be in the form of a fixed retainer of \$US250,000.00, payable quarterly in advance inclusive of expenses. The contractual period of this agreement is 3 years commencing February 1, 2001 to January 31, 2004. These terms remain in full effect until modified by both parties or the event of termination. The representation may be terminated by either party with thirty (30) days advance written notice. All fees and expenses shall be adjusted as of the termination date, with a refund or payment, as the case may be, made promptly.
