As you know, IRA credits have unlocked significant sources of investments in communities across the United States. In part thanks to many of these incentives, Korea is now proudly the largest foreign investor in the United States, helping facilitate the growth of strategic industries and restore US manufacturing dominance. However, ongoing uncertainty surrounding the status and future of these incentives is reducing the pace of Korean investments in the United States, and several Korean entities may have to exit the US market if these credits are repealed entirely.

Please let me know if you may be available to meet with the Embassy's team from the Economic Section of the ROK Embassy next week. We greatly appreciate your time, and thank you for your consideration.
