

Thank you for your letter informing me that the Directors of the Hard Cheese Association have decided to place my law offices on an annual retainer of \$6,000 for the calendar year 1974. It is agreed that this retainer shall commence on January 1, 1974. It is understood that this fee will include two U.S. Government hearings, or similar undertakings, concerning Austrian cheese should such arise in 1974. This retainer agreement will also include my sending your office direct information on dairy matters. It is also understood that should more than two hearings, or similar undertakings, arise in 1974 that my representation would be an extra charge to OEHEG pursuant to your office agreeing to such.

Pursuant to U.S. law, I will, prior to January 10, 1974, register with the Department of Justice as an agent of OEHEG.

If it meets with your approval, I will submit quarterly statements directly to your office in Innsbruck. Each quarterly statement will be in the amount of \$1,500 and will be posted at the end of each quarter. Please advise if you desire that I handle this billing on a different basis.

Karl, I look forward to a very pleasant and mutually beneficial relationship between my office and OEHEG. I feel that it is an asset that we have been good friends over the years and I look forward to our working together in the future.

I hope that you and your family enjoy a happy holiday season and a prosperous new year.
