



Dear Mr. Kuroda:

Confirming our recent understanding, we are pleased to accept representation of the Embassy of Japan as its General Counsel here in Washington in connection with such legal matters as your authorities shall request, commencing April 1, 1971 at an annual retainer of \$36,000 (U.S.) billed quarterly in advance, with actual disbursements billed at the conclusion of each quarter. We shall keep a detailed record of our time on your matters and will credit your retainer to that time on a fiscal year annual basis. If our services exceed the agreed retainer, we will submit a statement covering that excess at the end of the fiscal year. This arrangement is renewable annually with mutual consent.
