



Dear Senator Fulbright:

I want to thank you for your letter of July 22. The Government of Saudi Arabia is most interested in retaining you and your firm as counsel and advisor.

The Government of Saudi Arabia would like to have you and your firm available for counsel and guidance in connection with the laws and policies of the United States, possible Congressional or other action affecting those, as well as commercial and other ventures, and what steps might be appropriate and proper for us to consider from time to time. It is understood you will personally be in charge and handle the work done for us.

I would also be most interested in assuring that this representation should in no way inhibit you from continuing to express your own independent views on what you think the American interest in the Middle East is and should be.

We would be prepared to pay an annual retainer of \$50,000.00 (only fifty-thousand dollars and no cents) a year for your professional services, charged at standard, applicable rates. If your time for such services were to exceed the amount of the retainer, we would expect you, after consultation, to bill us for the excess.

The arrangement would be subject to review at the end of the year, as is our customary practice, and is subject to termination at any time by either party.

Dear Mr. Ambassador:

In response to your request, we are pleased to outline herewith the basis under which we would serve as counsel to the Government of Saudi Arabia, its departments and agencies.

As your counsel, we would be available for general legal representation, including consultation with you and other representatives of your Government in connection with any matter in which you might desire our services. This would include counsel with respect to policies of the Executive Branch of our Government, and legislative or other legal matters which might affect the interests of your country. In addition, we would be available to provide legal advice with respect to commercial or other ventures in which your Government is interested, as circumstances may require.

We will undertake this legal representation for an annual retainer of \$50,000 against which our professional services will be charged at standard applicable rates. If our time for such services were to exceed the amount of the retainer, we would, after consultation with you, bill you for the excess. In the event of specific and extended transactions, after consulting with you, we would open a separate account for any such transaction.

We contemplate that this arrangement will continue indefinitely, subject to termination at any time by either party.

We will be pleased to discuss this further with you at your convenience, if you so desire.
