

Dear Mr. Ambassador:

Supplementing our recent conversations and at your request we are pleased to undertake the representation of the Ministry of Tourism of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Bahamas here in Washington on the terms which are outlined herein.

Services of our firm will be available to you and other representatives of the Government of the Commonwealth in connection with all legal matters in which you desire our advice or assistance. We understand that initially this will include advice to and representation of the Commonwealth in air service matters including proceedings before the Civil Aeronautics Board. We contemplate also to advise and represent the Commonwealth in connection with the development of its tourism industry, including counsel with respect to legislative developments or Executive policies in the United States of interest to the Commonwealth. In addition, we are available to counsel with respect to matters relating to the economic and commercial development of the Bahamas.

We have proposed an annual retainer of \$25,000.00 against which professional time devoted to your matters will be charged at the usual billing rates of the attorney providing the services. Since this is an initial estimate of the value of services that might be required, if it appears that our charges will exceed that amount we will discuss that and reach agreement with you in advance. We would propose to submit our statement for these services quarterly in advance and to submit a statement to you at the end of each quarter covering disbursements made in your behalf. We anticipate that the retainer will be adjusted annually by mutual agreement based upon our developing experience.

We look forward to working closely with you and if this letter correctly records our understanding you may so indicate by signing the extra copy of this letter provided for that purpose and returning it to us.
