

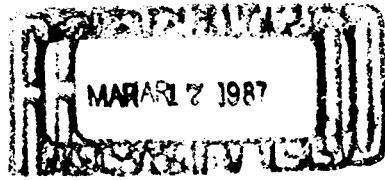

Dear Mr. Prime Minister:

This will confirm our understanding in our meeting in your offices Thursday, October 23, 1986.

It is agreed that, effective November 1, 1986 our firm will expand our present legal representation of the Ministry of Tourism of the Government of the Commonwealth in the United States to include the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Justice, the Ministry of Economic Affairs, your legal interests in bilateral negotiations in all areas and your trade, tourism and related legislative objectives. Our annual fee for all such services will be the sum of \$300,000, billed and payable quarterly in advance in such manner as you may prescribe, plus charges for travel, telephone, copying and postage incurred in connection with the performance of the aforesaid legal services. In the performance of our services we will work closely with your office, your Embassy in Washington, and the Ministries and government agencies for which we are providing legal representation.

This representational agreement shall continue in effect, subject to amendment by mutual agreement as to the fee and scope of services, until terminated on the anniversary date by either party by written notice to the other prior to September 1 of any year.


