

Their positions are not as partners, directors, or officers. The only agreement or understanding is an oral one of employment of each person.

- Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.


The Regional Sales Manager, District Sales Manager and both Sales Representatives have agreed in return for stated salaries to travel and promote through calls on travel agencies, airlines and corporations the sales of vacation tourist travel to the island of Jamaica by residents of the 11 southern United States. No one has a contract relating either to salary or duration.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

All personnel of the registrant engage in the distribution of tourist brochures, slides, films and travel information to the general public and through the means of calls upon travel agents, airlines, corporations, country clubs, associations, organizations, etc. The sales staff arrange for in store promotions by means of travel posters and handicrafts, enter trade shows and vacation shows by erection of booths and displays and in general try to get the name of Jamaica as a vacation paradise before the U.S. traveller.
