

Privacy Act Statement. Hydro-Quebec

1. Burson-Marsteller assisted Hydro-Quebec in connection with the promotion of its product, hydroelectric power, to private utility companies, electric power buying pools, and electric power distributors in the northeastern United States.
2. Burson-Marsteller assisted Hydro-Quebec in its efforts to expand public awareness of hydroelectric power as a desirable, nonpolluting, reusable energy resource.
