



Dear Sir,

Following our various discussions, I am writing to confirm the oral arrangement that you should join Mr. Barnett in his Washington Office on the 1st September 1973 with a view to your taking over from him as representative in Washington at a date to be decided by the Office Bearers. Up until that time you will work to Mr. Barnett, who is of course responsible to me and the Office Bearers; before you take over from him you will receive guidelines for your activities, but at all times you will remain responsible to me, the Chairman of the New York Advisory Committee and to the Office Bearers in Europe.

I confirm that the appointment carries a salary of \$45,000 per annum, which will fall for review from time to time. In addition, the shipowners will pay reasonable expenses by way of pension contributions, life and medical cover, including social security cover.

In addition, the following items fall for the account of the shipowners:-

- Rent of a small office;
- Office equipment as necessary;
- Salary of one Secretary;
- Telephone, telex and postage expenses;
- International Club membership, including monthly bills and membership of the Whitehall Club in New York.
- Reasonable other entertaining expenses;
- Travel expenses.

The shipowners retain the right to terminate this appointment at any time after three years, subject to three months' written notice; naturally you will have the same privilege in case you, on your part, should wish to terminate the appointment.
