The registrant's activity is to assure the fair consideration of the foreign principal's position in accordance with established practices and procedures, in connection with ongoing countervailing duty and anti-dumping investigations involving the marketing of nitrocellulose in the United States. The registrant will gather information, keep the foreign principal advised and contact appropriate U.S. officials and agencies to make representations to carry out the purpose cited above.

None of the registrant's activities will include contacts with quasi judicial bodies including the ITC, except in on-the-record at established proceedings or meetings.
