Uranerzbergbau-GmbH is owned as follows:


- a. 50% is owned by C. Deilmann A.G., a privately owned company engaged in exploration and drilling for oil and gas and in shaft sinking
- b. 50% is owned by Rheinische Braunkohlewerke A.G., ("RB"), a company engaged in lignite coal mining. RB is in turn wholly owned by Rheinische-Westfaelisches Elektrizitaetswerk A.G., an electric utility owned by various German municipalities and private shareholders.

We do not have sufficient information to determine the full extent, if any, of any direction, control, financing, or subsidization of Uranerzbergbau GmbH by any foreign government, foreign political party, or other foreign principal other than as described above.
