

Preparation of submissions and briefs and statements before appropriate U.S. Government agencies, including Committees of the U.S. Congress; drafting and filing of comments on proposed legislation; testimony before the House Ways and Means Subcommittee on Trade; comments to the Senate Finance Subcommittee on International Trade; preparation of statistical information and inquiries on the status of legislation and Administration reports.

6. Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act? ^{1/} Yes No

If yes, describe all such political activities indicating, among other things, the relations, interests or policies to be influenced together with the means to be employed to achieve this purpose.

Activities were undertaken to support passage of H.R. 1910, a bill to suspend temporarily import duties on certain tartaric chemicals. In response to announcements of the Subcommittee on Trade of the House Ways and Means Committee, dated April 15, 1981 and June 5, 1981, a written statement was submitted and testimony offered to the Subcommittee on June 15, 1981, in support of the bill. H.R. 1910 was consolidated in H.R. 4566, Section 15, and passed by the House. In response to an announcement of the Senate Finance Subcommittee on International Trade, dated October 19, 1981, a written statement was submitted to the Subcommittee on November 6, 1981 in support of the appropriate section of the bill. Informational inquiries were made concerning the progress of the bill throughout the 97th Congress. The bill was passed by the Senate in December, 1982, and enacted on January 12, 1983 as P.L. No. 97-446.

Confirming our recent conversation this will set forth our understanding concerning action to suspend present Customs duties on certain tartaric chemicals imported into the United States under TSUS items 425.94, 426.72, 426.76, and 426.82.

Barnes, Richardson & Colburn will advise, counsel and assist you in connection with measures to decrease or suspend existing United States duty rates which have resulted from recent trade negotiations, and to make representations on your behalf before the appropriate branches and agencies of the United States Government.

You undertook to pay fees and costs in an amount not exceeding \$5000 for professional services already rendered and to be rendered during the coming month.

If the foregoing correctly reflects our understanding, please sign and return the enclosed duplicate original of this letter. This will serve as sufficient agreement between us.


