

Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge and thank you for appointing Hannaford International, Inc. ("HII") as U.S. public relations/public affairs counsel for The Lebanese Resistance ("LR", known in Lebanon as The Lebanese Forces), and to set forth the terms of our working relationship.

The Lebanese Resistance agrees to pay HII a minimum of \$5,000 a month for its services. If time invested by HII on behalf of LR exceeds \$5,000 in any given month, it may bill up to a maximum of \$9,000 for the month without prior client approval. Any billing over a total of \$9,000 for services in a given month will require prior approval by the client.

The base fee of \$5,000 a month is payable in advance. That is, by the first day of the month for which services are to be performed. At the end of each month, HII will invoice LR for any additional services performed during that month, along with any out-of-pocket expenses incurred on behalf of LR. These monthly reconciliation invoices will be due and payable within thirty (30) days of invoice date. Past due balances will be subject to a service charge of one-and-one-half per cent a month.

The effective date of this agreement will be June 10, 1982 and it will be in effect through May, 1983. During the life of the agreement it may be modified at any time by mutual consent.

During the month of May, 1983, the parties will review this agreement to determine if it will be extended, modified or concluded.


