
5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

The oral understanding between the Registrant and the Foreign Principal contemplates that the Registrant engage in activities as described in response to question 4 above relating to trade and other matters between United States entities (including the United States Government) and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia concerning both a private and government-to-government matters.
