The foreign principal is owned, directed and controlled by the Government of India by virtue of ownership and of 100 percent of its stock in the name of the President of India and the President's consequent power to nominate and elect the directors. Further, while the Shipping Corporation of India is run on a profit basis, it does receive loans from international organizations, the Shipping Development Fund of India (which is a government organization supported principally by loans from private parties) and the United Kingdom.



Dear Mr. Sorenson:

I understand that as part of your duties as general shipping agent for The Shipping Corporation of India Ltd. (hereinafter "SCI"), that you have been authorized to obtain counsel for that corporation. This letter when accepted by you, will serve as a complete agreement on the terms of our representation of SCI. This agreement reflects our previous discussions of the needs of SCI in connection with its regulation under The Shipping Act of 1978 and reflects our understanding of SCI's needs in light of preliminary research and investigation.


LeBoeuf, Lamb, Leiby & MacRae (hereinafter LLL&M) will supply information and analysis to SCI concerning the law of the United States Government applicable to the regulation of "controlled carriers" under The Shipping Act of 1978. This agreement will confirm that this scope of work shall be expanded to include legislation before Congress which would extend exemptions under the Act to carriers in certain developing countries. LLL&M may in the future make presentations to Members of Congress, Congressional Staff members, executive branch and independent regulatory agency officials, directed toward favorable regulatory treatment of SCI under the existing Act or under the Act as it may be amended by Congress. LLL&M will periodically advise SCI with progress reports, copies of which will be provided to you and such others as designated by SCI. In conducting such services, we will be directed by SCI which may relay instructions through your office. In this connection, I look forward to meeting Admiral R. K. S. Ghandi, managing director of SCI, when he comes to New York in September and to receive his further instructions on this matter. LLL&M will provide such other services as SCI may require.

This agreement shall continue in effect at the mutual pleasure of SCI and LLL&M. LLL&M will charge SCI its normal hourly billing rates, and SCI will be billed, in care of your office, on a quarterly basis for such fees and incidental disbursements.

This agreement will become effective upon our receipt of your approval on behalf of SCI as indicated below.
