



For the purpose of conducting research on Communication Gap between the United States and Japan, the Japan Trade Center, New York (hereafter referred to as JTC) and Interface International, Inc. (hereafter referred to as III) have agreed that:

1. III will make available to JTC, the results of such research upon completion, not later than March 31, 1980.
2. The total cost of such research which JTC will pay to III will be Twenty-four Thousand Dollars (US\$24,000.00) payable Twelve Thousand Dollars (US\$12,000.00) on initiation of the research and Twelve Thousand Dollars (US\$12,000.00) upon completion and submission of the study to JTC.
3. The results of the research set forth above will be the property of JTC and will not be released without mutual consent of III and JTC.
