

Dear Mr. Chitunda:

This letter will confirm our recent discussions and outline the terms and conditions under which TKC International, Inc. (TKC II) will provide consulting services to UNIAO Nacional para Independencia Total de Angola ("UNIAO").

For a twelve month period, commencing on the date funds are deposited with Women's National Bank as specified in detail below, TKCII will be responsible for the following activities:

- (A) monitoring and preparing factual reports on Congressional and Executive activities which might affect or have impact on UNIAO.
- (B) monitoring and preparing factual reports on the level of understanding the United States has of the problems in Angola.
- (C) providing advice, analysis and subjective counseling regarding the general promotions of a better understanding between UNIAO and the United States.

UNIAO agrees to pay TKCII an annual retainer of US\$198,000, plus expenses not to exceed US\$10,000 without prior approval. The fee shall be paid on a quarterly basis (US\$49,500) in advance. The first quarter payment and the expense payment (US\$10,000) shall be due upon execution of this agreement or no later than five (5) days thereafter. TKCII shall invoice UNIAO each quarter

for the current quarter retainer fee. UNIAO shall remit all quarterly retainer payments within five (5) days by bank wire to the account of TKC International, Incorporated at Women's National Bank, 1627 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. account number 0034307201, or by check drawn on a United States bank.

It is mutually understood and agreed that this contract can be terminated without cause by either party upon the giving of ninety (90) days prior written notice. Further, that this contract may be renewed for a like or unlike term. Renewal shall take place thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of this agreement.

If the above meets with your approval, please acknowledge your acceptance of these terms and conditions continued above by signing the enclosed copy of this letter and returning the same to me.
