TKC International will provide monthly reports regarding U.S. policy toward the U.S. Trust Territory of Palau and report immediately any activity that Kawasho should be aware of.



Dear Mr. Iida:

Thank you for your response of November 27 indicating that our proposal has passed your "Nemawashi" test. We are delighted to begin intensifying our efforts of keeping you and Kawasho Corporation informed of the U.S. Government's activities regarding the Palau issue.

The contract period between TKC International, Inc. and Kawasho Corporation shall be for twelve months commencing December 1, 1990. The Agreement may be terminated by either party after six months by giving a thirty day written cancellation notice.

TKC International, Inc. will provide the following services to Kawasho Corporation:

1. Monitor the activities of U.S. Department of Interior officials and appropriate Congressional authorities as they develop and implement policies for U.S. interaction with Palau. Specifically, we will provide Kawasho with information about the attitudes and future plans of those policy makers who have influence over how the U.S. will handle the Palau issue;
2. Provide monthly reports regarding U.S. policy toward Palau and report immediately any activity that Kawasho should be aware of; and
3. Prepare the itinerary, schedule and accompany to meetings, and assist in meeting evaluation for a Washington visit by a Kawasho representative(s) during the first quarter of 1991. This representative would meet key policy makers and staff in order to increase government officials' recognition and understanding of the real business problems that have resulted from Palau's government problems. These meetings would also allow the Kawasho representative to gain a first-hand assessment of these policy makers and their attitudes toward dealing with Palau.

For these services, Kawasho Corporation agrees to wire transfer to TKC International, Inc. an annual fee of \$15,000, payable in semiannual installments of \$7,500 upon signing this agreement and \$7,500 on June 1, 1991. Out-of-pocket expenses incurred by TKC International, Inc. for such items as telephone, postage, local travel and other activities on behalf of Kawasho Corporation will not exceed \$3,000 for the year and shall be reimbursed upon Kawasho Corporation's receipt of quarterly expense invoices.


