

Activities referred to in Item 12 related exclusively to meetings held with the Agreements Compliance Division of International Trade Administration in the Department of Commerce to discuss JISEA's position on the Department's "Steel Trigger Price Mechanism Procedures Manual," including both technical suggestions and policy matters. The proposed manual was published in the Federal Register and comments requested (46 Fed. Reg. 22738 of April 20, 1981). Meetings were held on 7/7/81, 7/14/81, 9/16/81, 9/18/81, and 9/24/81 with Ms. F. Lynn Holec, Director of the above division and various staff members including Mr. Spetrini, Mr. Tolerico, and Ms. Link.
