Addendum to Questions 11 and 12

Registrant, in filing its Supplemental Statement believed, and continues to believe, that its activities in connection with its legal representation of Creusot-Loire, S.A. are exempt from registration under exemption (g), but registered as a precaution in the event that it might engage in non-exempt activities. It has not. Its representation of Creusot-Loire, S.A. was disclosed to all participating agencies and all government officials with whom Registrant's attorneys discussed this matter. All contacts with government officials were directly related to the proceedings initiated by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of the Department of Treasury, and did not include non-exempt "political activities."

In response to the request of the Department of Justice in its letter of December 9, 1981, however, Registrant voluntarily sets forth hereunder a list of all 1981 meetings shown in Registrant's records with government officials in connection with the issues raised in the Federal Register notice of November 17, 1980, 45 FR 75834. Mr. William Walker participated in all meetings on behalf of Registrant; Messrs. David Vaughan, William Laino, and Marc Miller participated in some of the meetings on behalf of the Registrant.

Each such meeting took place in the direct context of an effort to secure removal of the exclusion order issued against nickel-bearing stainless steel from Creusot-Loire, and were undertaken in the course of agency proceedings.

This proceeding was initiated in furtherance of enforcement of the Cuban Assets Control Regulation, 31 C.F.R. § 515, which

excludes products of Cuban origin from entering U.S. commerce, a policy which was not then, and is not now, in question. In the course of these proceedings and the meetings listed above, no attempts were made to influence or persuade officials with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States concerning the policy of excluding products of Cuban origin from the United States, or with reference to the political or public interests, policies or relations of the government of a foreign country or a foreign political party concerning entry of materials of Cuban origin to U.S. commerce. Among the issues discussed in the meetings listed above was a certificate of origin procedure to permit the entry into the U.S. of nickel-bearing stainless steel from Creusot-Loire which does not contain nickel of Cuban origin.

The last phrase in response to Question 11 should be amended to read "and participation in meetings with officials of OFAC, USTR, and the Departments of Treasury, State, and Defense."
