The Foreign Principal has retained the Registrant law firm for the purpose of providing legal advice and representation in order to obtain relief in connection with the proceedings initiated by the action of the Office of Foreign Assets Control as announced in the Federal Register of November 17, 1980, 45 FR 75834. Registrant shall be compensated at the usual hourly rates for partners, associates and other employees, and expenses shall be reimbursed by the Foreign Principal. There is no duration to this agreement, and it may be terminated by the Registrant or the Foreign Principal at any time.

Registrant has been retained to provide legal advice and representation as described in Item 3 above. This performance will be accomplished by undertaking legal research, preparation of legal memoranda, formal and informal presentations to government officials, participation in formal and informal agency proceedings, and correspondence and meetings with government officials.



The activities described herein have been undertaken in connection with the proceedings initiated by the action of the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) as set forth in the Federal Register on November 17, 1980, 45 FR 75834. In the course of said proceedings, Registrant may engage in non-exempt political activities as defined in 1(o) of the Act using the methods of performance described above. The Registrant is seeking relief from the effects of the OFAC action for the Foreign Principal. While its activities to date have all been with reference to proceedings outlined in 31 CFR Part 515, it may be that performance of Registrant's services will at some point involve political activities in order to effect remedies that go beyond those provided for in 31 CFR § 515 Subpart H. At present, however, Registrant's activity is limited to obtaining special licenses to allow entry of the Foreign Principal's products and seeking to establish certification procedures provided for in 31 CFR §§ 515.536 and 515.808(c) (1).
