

The Foreign Principal has retained the Registrant law firm for the purpose of providing legal advice and representation in connection with countervailing duty and antidumping proceedings before the International Trade Commission, the Department of Commerce, and, possibly, other agencies of the Executive Branch of the U.S. government. Registrant shall be compensated at the usual hourly rates for partners, associates and other employees, and expenses shall be reimbursed by the Foreign Principal. There is no duration to this agreement, and it may be terminated by the Registrant or the Foreign Principal at any time.

4. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

Registrant has been retained to provide legal advice and representation as described in Item 3 above. This performance will be accomplished by undertaking legal research, preparation of legal documents, appearances at formal and informal agency hearings, and correspondence and meetings with officials of appropriate government agencies.



The activities described herein have been undertaken in connection with antidumping and countervailing duty actions instituted on November 12, 1981, and involving the Foreign Principal and numerous other foreign steel manufacturers. Although Registrant law firm's activities undertaken on behalf of the Foreign Principal are in direct connection with the formal and informal proceedings before the Department of Commerce and International Trade Commission, and consequently are exempt from registration under § 3(g) of the Act, during the course of said proceedings registrant may engage in non-exempt political activity as defined in § 1(o) of the Act using the methods of performance described above, and is therefore filing this Exhibit in anticipation of that possibility.

^{1/} Political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act means the dissemination of political propaganda and any other activity which the person engaging therein believes will, or which he intends to, prevail upon, indoctrinate, convert, induce, persuade, or in any other way influence any agency or official of the Government of the United States or any section of the public within the United States with reference to formulating, adopting, or changing the domestic or foreign policies of the United States or with reference to the political or public interests, policies, or relations of a government of a foreign country or a foreign political party.
