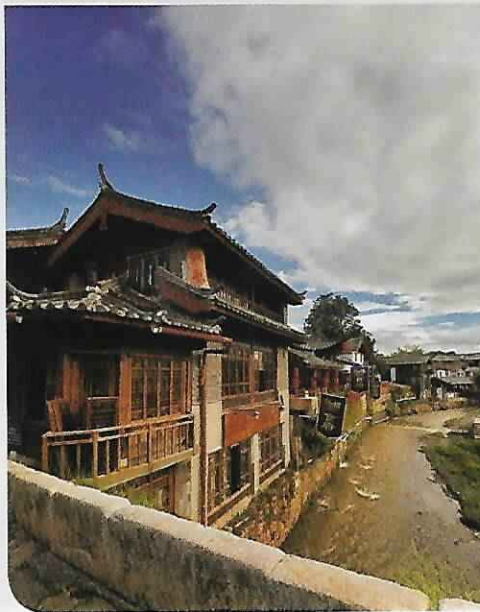
Lijiang

Lugu Lake

Lugu Lake has fascinating colors and ancient legends. Ancient Mosuo people settled by the lake are the only ethnic group that adopts a system of matriarchy in China, practicing the unique "walking marriage" custom, where "men do not take a wife, and women are not married off."

Shuhe Ancient Town

In Shuhe Ancient Town, situated near the mountain and by the river, residential buildings are well arranged. It is the home of Naxi ancestors in Lijiang, a well-preserved important market town on the Ancient Tea Horse Road, and the birthplace of Chieftain Mu.

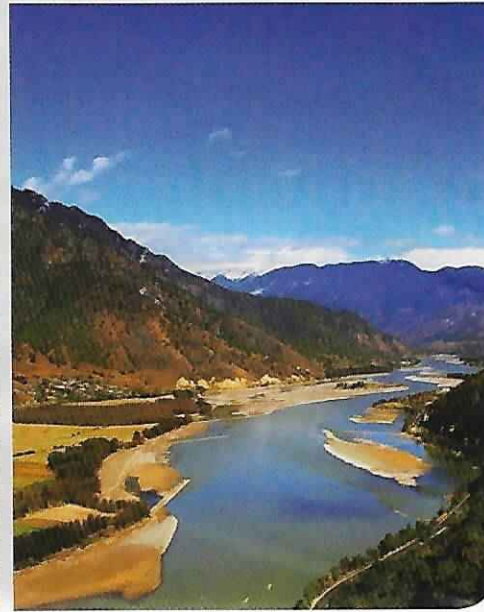


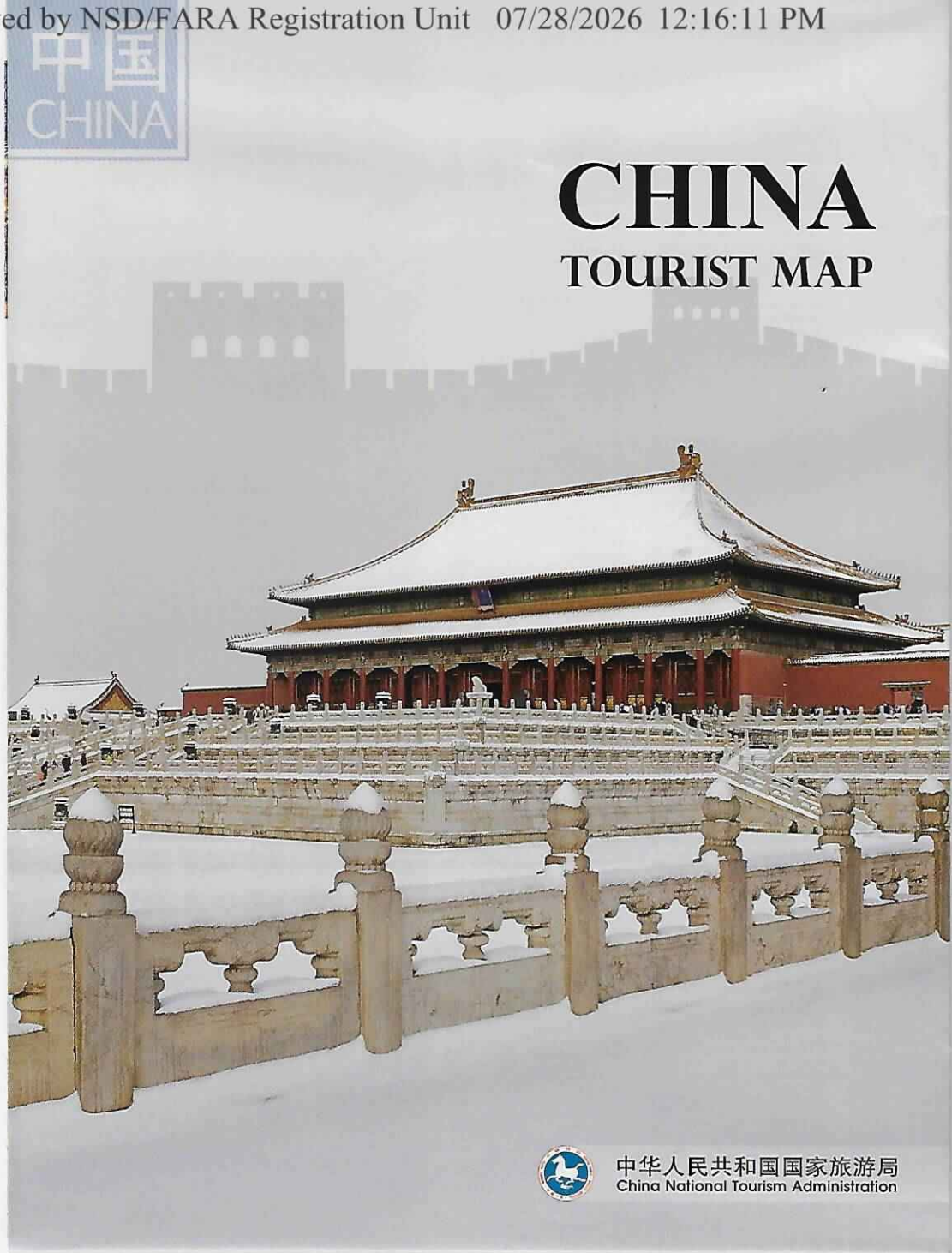
Lashihai

Lashihai is a highland lake with picturesque scenery, lush forests, and dense flowers and plants. Like a mirror, the lake reflects the Jade Dragon Snow Mountain, where hibernating waterfowl rest peacefully, forming the unique atmosphere of the plateau wetland.

First Bay of the Yangtze River

Blocked by Hailuo cliffs, the rolling Yangtze River is forced to make a big V-shaped bend and flow northeast. This bend is the famous first bay of the Yangtze River.





Guangzhou

Guangzhou, the capital of Guangdong Province, is known as the "City of Flowers". Guangzhou borders on the South China Sea and is 182 km from Hong Kong. It is the No. 1 city in South China and one of China's windows opening to the outside world. China Export Commodities Fair (The Guangzhou Fair) is held twice a year in spring and autumn, respectively. Located in the subtropical zone, Guangzhou has a moderate climate. The main tourist attractions in Guangzhou include the Chen Family Shrine, Temple of Six Banyan Trees, Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall, Qingping Market, Yuexiu Park, White Cloud Mountain, etc.. It is very convenient for tourists to go from Guangzhou to other provinces and municipalities by air, highways, railways and waterways. The main local artworks include jade carvings, Guangdong embroidery and sandalwood fans.

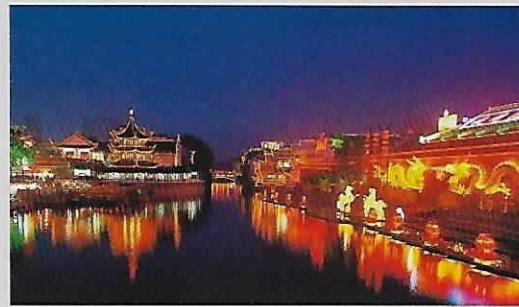

Xi'an

Xi'an, the capital of Shaanxi Province, was called Chang'an in ancient China. In the Han (206 BC-AD 220) and Tang (618-907) dynasties, Xi'an reached its heyday, featuring the gorgeous palaces and a well-conceived layout of the city. The famous "Silk Road" took Xi'an as the starting point, and then extended to the west. Xi'an boasts a large number of tourist attractions, such as the terracotta warriors and horses of Emperor Qin Shihuang, Greater Wild Goose Pagoda, Lesser Wild Goose Pagoda, Forest of Steles, Drum Tower, Huaqing Pool, Xi'an City Wall, Site of Banpo Village Ruins, Site of Lantian Man and Mount Hua. The Mausoleum of Emperor Qin Shihuang and the pits of terracotta warriors and horses have been included in the *World Heritage List*. The arts and crafts produced by Xi'an are simple, undecorated and novel, such as the reproductions of terracotta figurines of the Qin Dynasty, imitated three-color glazed pottery of the Tang Dynasty, miniature engravings and folk handicrafts.

Nanjing

Nanjing, the capital of Jiangsu Province, is located on the lower reaches of the Yangtze River. It once served as the capital of ten different dynasties in Chinese history; hence it enjoys a reputation of being the "capital for ten dynasties". The main tourist attractions in Nanjing include Sun Yat-sen Mausoleum, Qinhui River Scenic Zone, Confucius Temple, Xiaoling Mausoleum of the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644), Xuanwu Lake, Rain and Flower Terrace and Qixia Mountain, in addition to the Zijin Mountain Observatory, the largest observatory in China, and the Nanjing Yangtze River Bridge, the first double-decked bridge with double railway tracks below and a four-lane highway above designed by China. The special local products of Nanjing include dry-cured ducks, rain and flower stones and ancient-style woodcarvings. The traditional Chinese paintings and calligraphic works of Nanjing are also well known. Tourists can go from Nanjing to Beijing, Shanghai, Tianjin and Jinan by train; or to Huangshan Mountain, Hangzhou and Suzhou by bus.

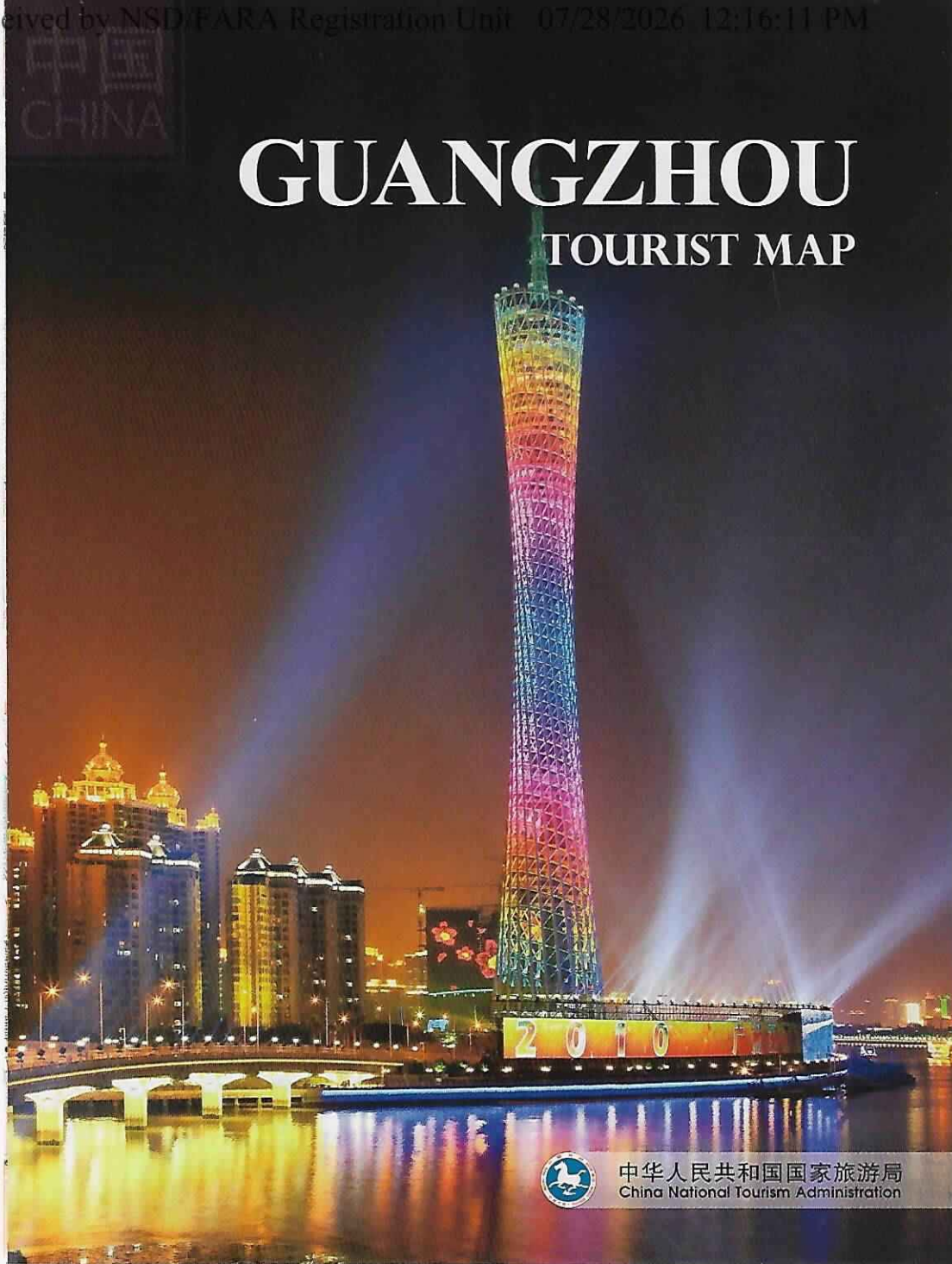

Yaomiao Temple

Dahuaishu Ancestral Memorial Garden Scenic Area

The Dahuaishu Ancestral Memorial Garden Scenic Area was the departure point for the great immigration of the late Yuan and early

Ming dynasties, and has now become a holy place for Chinese to seek their roots and worship their ancestors. The scenic spot is themed on "Seeking Roots and Worshipping Ancestors" and divided into three unique parts.

Hongtong Ming Dynasty Prison

The Hongtong Ming Dynasty Prison is the only well preserved ancient prison of the Ming Dynasty in China. It was built during the first year of the Hongwu Period (1368). In the Peking Opera "Su San under Police Escort," the courtesan Su San was unjustly wronged in Hongtong and imprisoned here.
