Subject: Cosponsor Consideration for the Partnership with Korea Act

Hi Scott- Hope you are well. I wanted to check if Representative Lowenthal would consider once again cosponsoring the Partner with Korea Act, led by Reps. Roskam and Connolly (HR 2106, reintroduced last month, text here). Rep. Lowenthal cosponsored in both the 113th and 114th Congress.

As in the past two Congresses, the bill as drafted would create a visa for professional Koreans capped at 15,000 per year, identical in form to the E-3 visa for Australian professionals - renewable every two years, but not convertible to a green card.

If your boss would like to cosponsor or if you have any questions, feel free to contact Omri Rahmil (Rep. Roskam) or Molly Claire Cole (Rep. Connolly). I'll follow up next week, but feel free to ping me with any questions.
