



RRNA will respond to the invitation of the United States International Trade Commission for information and views (1) on the probable economic effects of proposals (embodied in a bill introduced to the 94th Congress) to change the U.S. tariffs, as well as making requirements; on electronic tariffs and (2) on the need to protect a domestic industry. This will be done through oral and written testimony. The activities may also entail other contracts to explain or to elaborate on the information and views formulated to the USITC or other official bodies that may be engaged in the further deliberations on the possible change in tariffs or other measures affecting the importations into the United States of electronic watches. The objective of the RRNA work is to ensure that U.S. authorities understand all the implications of a possible increase in U.S. duties or intensification of other trade restorations.
