

Privacy Act Statement. 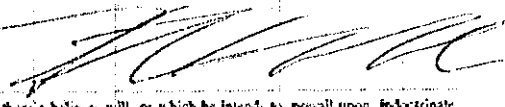

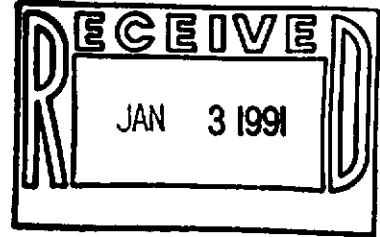

This letter will constitute an agreement under the laws of the District of Columbia between Alcalde, Rousselot and Fay (hereinafter referred to as the "Firm") and the International Council of Cruise Lines (hereinafter referred to as "ICCL").

Effective January 1, 1991, the Firm will serve as a representative of the ICCL in Washington, D.C. and will provide counsel and assistance on legislative and regulatory matters which affect the passenger cruise industry.

For these services, ICCL shall pay the Firm a monthly fee of \$21,000 in advance upon being invoiced, and out of pocket costs (such as long distance calls, copying, postage, etc.), which shall also be invoiced on a monthly basis.

Please sign and return to us the enclosed duplicate copy of this letter. This agreement may be terminated by either party on 60 days prior written notice to the other party.
