

Privacy Act Statement. 

**LETTER OF INTENT**

Dear Mr. Bluffer:

It is Edelman's policy to document in contractual form the terms under which it accepts client assignments so there will be no misunderstandings at a later date. Recognizing, however, that final agreement on the contract can be delayed for various reasons, we ask you or another authorized representative of UKR Investment, Inc. to sign this interim letter authorizing us to commence work on your behalf. We will bill you an amount of \$65,000 as compensation during the months of January through March, 2001 for our public affairs services, including media relations and governmental relations. The billing will proceed as follows: \$25,000 for our services in January, \$20,000 for services in February and \$20,000 for services in the month of March; plus out-of-pocket costs which include a 10% service charge (other than with respect to travel and entertainment expenses reimbursable to Edelman employees) and a 6% administrative charge for internal expenses. Internal expenses consist of local phone, fax, copier, postage, e-mail, internet/extranet charges and database administration costs.
