India's EDM Artists Taking Center Stage at WAVES 2025: Meet the Breakout Finalists of 'Resonate'

Hope you're well! Wanted to put a rising story on your radar from India's evolving EDM scene that's making serious waves.

Three electronic music producers from Assam — **Aditya Upadhyaya (Guwahati)**, **Dibyajit Ray (Bongaigaon)** and **Nobajyoty Boruah (Lakhimpur)** — have been named Top 10 finalists for **Resonate: The EDM Challenge**, a premier talent spotlight under the **'Create in India' initiative** at the **World Audio Visual & Entertainment Summit (WAVES) 2025**, taking place in Mumbai this May 1-4.

This national-level recognition marks a breakthrough moment for Northeast India's often-overlooked music scene — especially for **Nobajyoty Boruah**, who's gaining attention for his genre-blending sound and inspiring DIY rise. Starting with YouTube tutorials and now a certified audio engineer, Nobajyoty has worked across Chennai and Bangalore, pulling sonic inspiration from A.R. Rahman to Porter Robinson. His recent remix of Salim-Sulaiman's "*Eik Martaba*" (out via Merchant Records/Warner Music India) is already turning heads.

All three Assamese artists will perform live at [WAVES 2025](#), offering a glimpse into the future of Indian electronic music with cultural depth and global ambition.
