

COP30 is about people - and urgent action to improve lives. She highlights how Indigenous Peoples, as holders of millenary knowledge, are also indispensable partners in this effort.

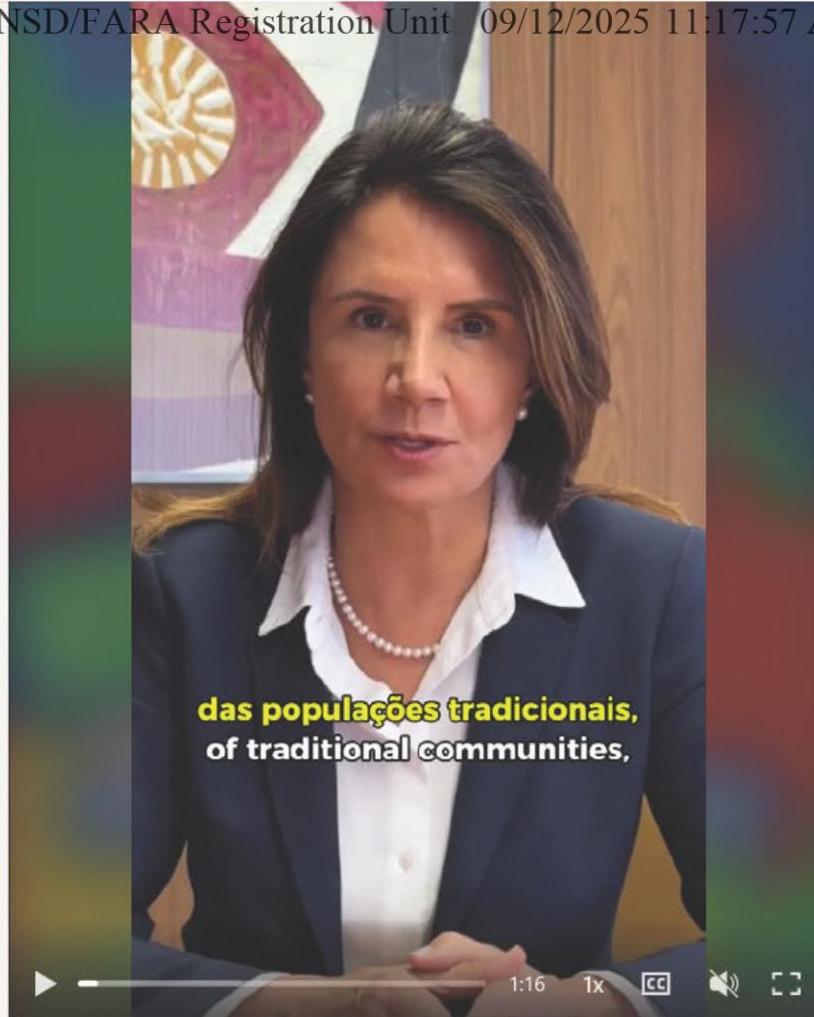
"Resenha COP30" is a series of conversations on the official [COP30 Brazil](#) Instagram, unveiling what is at stake at this year's conference.

The message was clear. Solidarity, responsibility and justice must guide implementation. Only then can the Paris Agreement's promise become reality and protect the most vulnerable communities.

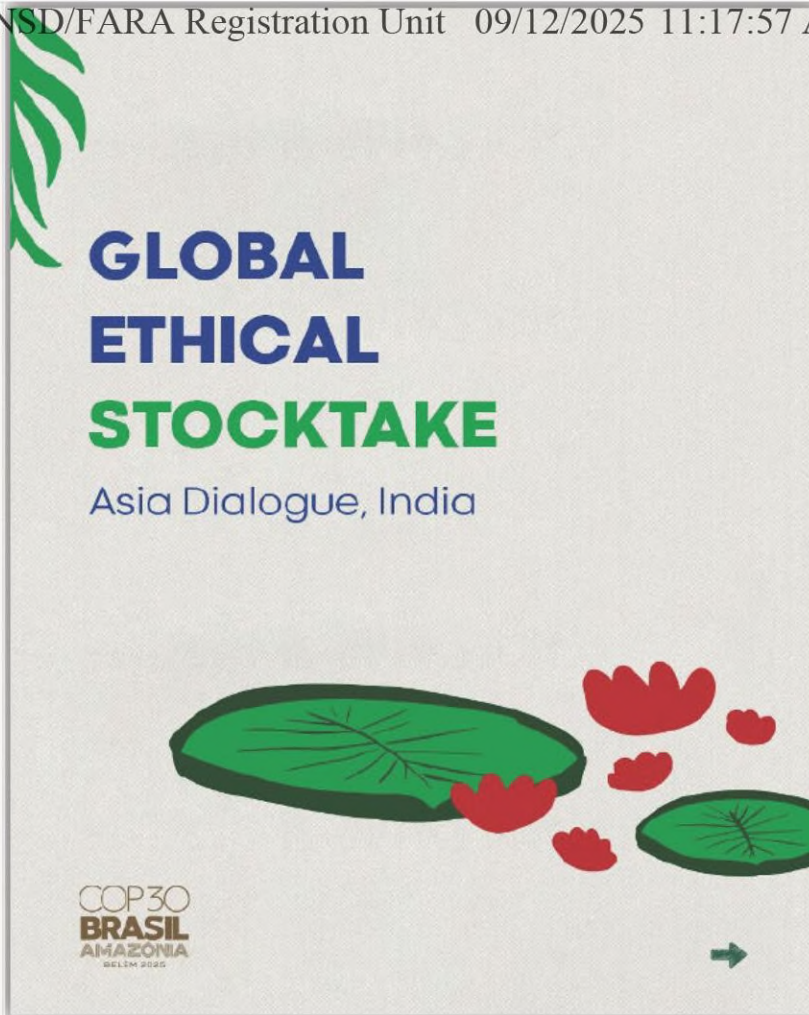
- Ethics as a compass for climate decisions

Environment ministers from 22 countries met in Mexico City for a regional preparatory session ahead of COP30.

Hosted by the Government of Mexico and the COP30 Presidency, the discussions focused on accelerating implementation and turning climate agreements into real-world solutions that protect people's lives.

- Key priorities included:
- Strengthening NDCs for 2035
 - Scaling resilience and adaptation efforts
 - Mobilizing climate finance at scale

As COP30 President-Designate Ambassador André Corrêa do Lago stressed: "We have already negotiated. Now we must implement solutions."

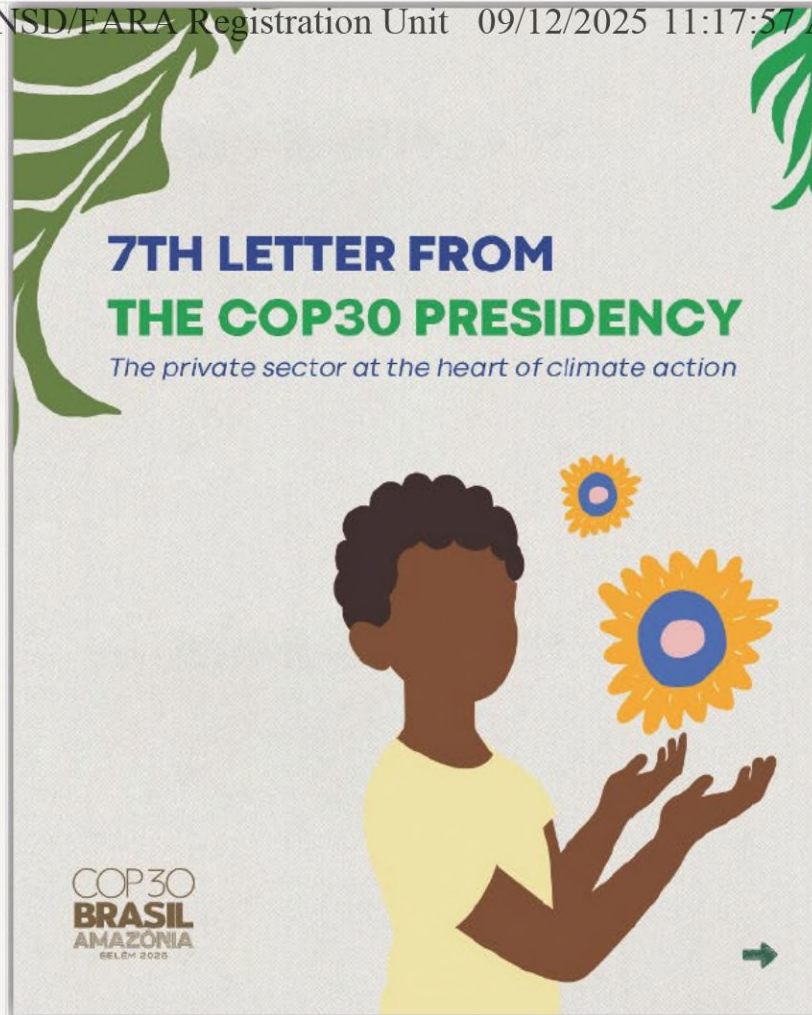

In his 6th Letter to the International Community, COP30 President-Designate André Aranha Corrêa do Lago reaffirms a simple truth: COP30 is about all of us.

It is not about Brazil or the incoming Presidency, but about our collective responsibility to deliver for present and future generations.

The letter introduces COP30 Presidency Consultations, starting with an online session with all Parties, followed by in-person dialogues in New York during UNGA80, in Brasília at the Pre-COP, and finally in Belém. These consultations allow the COP30 Presidency to continue discussions on topics raised by Parties during the Bonn Climate Change Conference (SB 62) this year that are not covered under formal agenda items. They are designed to keep the process inclusive, transparent and on track.

Three priorities will guide the road to Belém: reinforcing multilateralism, connecting

The framework for negotiators focuses on:

NDCs for 2035: national commitments must add up to a safe and prosperous future.

Finance via the Baku to Belém Roadmap: scaling climate finance for developing countries, with a focus on adaptation and MDB reform.

Adaptation, GST and Just Transition: building on progress made at the [UN Climate Change](#) in Bonn to deliver breakthroughs on GGA indicators, GST implementation and the Just Transition Work Program.

Smooth Process Management: lean agendas and early consultations to resolve bottlenecks.

The Spirit of the Global Mutirão: unity over division, action over delay, legacy over inertia.

This year marks the 10th anniversary of the Paris Agreement. A decade of resilience and results, and also a reminder that every fraction of a degree counts. With 4 out of 5 countries yet to submit their 2035 NDCs, COP30 is the moment to turn ambition into implementation, innovation and inclusion.

Next milestone: the UN Secretary-General's High-Level Event during the United Nations General Assembly on 24 September, a decisive moment for countries to present their new 2035 targets and reaffirm their commitment to COP30 and the Paris Agreement.
