Sharing a brief recap on today's developments from the COP30 Presidency:

1. **Brazil's President Da Silva delivered [the remarks at the opening ceremony of the 80<sup>th</sup> UNGA](#)**, where he declared, "*COP30, in Belém, will be the COP of truth. It will be the time for world leaders to prove the seriousness of their commitment to the planet. Without a complete picture of the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs), we are walking blindfolded towards the abyss.*"
2. **President Da Silva announced Brazil's \$1billion commitment to the Tropical Forests Forever Facility (TFFF).**

3. **President Da Silva [joined a number of world leaders in signing a joint letter in favor of the energy transition](#).**
  - a. Brazil is joined by leaders from the UK, South Africa, Australia and more in signing the document, entitled "*All Hands On Deck for the Just and Equitable Energy Transition.*"
4. **The COP30 Presidency announced its [Granary of Solutions platform](#):**
  - a. The Granary of Solutions platform showcases a collection of sustainable solutions demonstrating how the implementation of the Paris Agreement is taking place on the ground and around the world.
5. **In El Pais, Christiana Figueres penned an [op-ed declaring](#), "*The Belém COP can be remembered as the moment when international climate diplomacy shifted decisively from promises to delivery.*"**
