● A Transformative Week for Climate Action at [#UNGA80](#) and [#ClimateWeekNYC](#)

At UNGA80 this week, the world came together in New York to demonstrate the might of multilateralism, that people are connected and committed to urgent climate action and that we have the solutions we need to implement the Paris Agreement.

For the COP30 Brazilian Presidency, the week marked important progress in advancing our mission and shaping a new era of delivery, optimism, and collective action as part of the [#GlobalMutirão](#).

🚩 Key Highlights from the Week:

■ Over 100 NDCs pledged: At the [United Nations Climate Summit](#), led by [Antônio Guterres](#) and President [Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva](#), more than 100 countries committed to submit new 2035 NDCs ahead of Belém - now covering nearly 70% of global emissions.

■ Launch of the Granary of Solutions: Alongside [Climate High-Level Champions](#), COP30 unveiled the new platform at the center of the Action Agenda, showcasing a first wave of climate solutions already delivering impact and designed to inspire and accelerate implementation.

■ Progress on Tropical Forests Forever Facility (TFFF): President Lula announced Brazil's landmark \$1 billion contribution, underscoring the central role forests play in global climate action.

10 High-level Solutions Dialogues: From cutting methane and industrial decarbonization to information integrity and resilient health systems, the Presidency in



Sessions advanced planning for adaptation finance, jobs and skills, food systems, multilevel governance, fire management, grid resilience, and more.

Introducing Maloca to Advance Global Inclusivity: Through a new, interactive platform launched today, COP30 is reimagined inclusive participation in COPs. "Through the Maloca we can make sure that this COP is really the most inclusive possible, and that it can reach other generations," said COP30 Brazil President-Designate Ambassador Corrêa do Lago during the launch event.

Youth leadership: COP30 Youth Champion [Marcele Oliveira](#) took the stage at multiple events, including the 30th anniversary of the UN World Programme of Action on Youth, to ensure youth voices remain central to climate ambition.

This week demonstrated that the global commitment to climate action is strong and what is possible when we come together to make collective progress for people.

We leave New York energized and inspired. Next stop: Pre-COP in Brasilia, October 13-14.

● Day 2 at UNGA / Climate Week NYC: Scaling Solutions, Supporting People

Today was marked by bold leadership, concrete action, accelerating the solutions that work and a renewed call for global unity.

■ President Lula at the UN General Assembly

In his address opening the 80th session, President [Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva](#) brought the climate crisis to the center of the UN Debate. In his remarks, he made an urgent appeal for action calling for real and immediate commitments from all nations: "The time has come to move from the negotiation phase to the implementation stage. It is necessary to bring the fight against climate change to the heart of the UN, so that it has the attention it deserves. A Council linked to the General Assembly with the strength and legitimacy to monitor commitments will give coherence to climate action."

■ Launch of the Granary of Solutions

Alongside the [Climate High-Level Champions](#), the COP30 Presidency launched the Granary of Solutions Platform at [#ClimateWeekNYC](#) – showcasing a collection of sustainable solutions demonstrating global climate progress since the Paris Agreement. This platform highlights solutions already delivering impact, and how they can be scaled to accelerate progress.

■ Tropical Forests Forever Facility (TFFF)

President Lula announced a landmark US\$1 billion contribution to TFFF, signaling Brazil's determination to lead by example and encourage others to step up.

■ Solutions Dialogues

■ Financing Forests: Tropical Forest Forever Facility (TFFF) Presidential Event

■ Non-State Actors – convening leaders from across sectors to accelerate implementation.

■ Information Integrity – highlighting the importance of trusted, transparent information to underpin climate action, with Minister Marina Silva.

■ Industrial Decarbonization – exploring how transforming heavy industries can drive opportunity, growth, and sustainable development.

■ Action Agenda Deep Dives

Today's Finance for Adaptation roundtable – co-hosted with The Atlanta city Council and [Natural Resources Defense Council \(NRDC\)](#) – advanced the conversation on the COP30 Plan to Accelerate Solutions (PAS) by spotlighting the Facility for Investible National Adaptation Planning & Implementation (FINI). The discussion centered on how

to align financial flows with nationally determined adaptation priorities, ensuring that

planning efforts translate into real implementation on the ground.

challenge now is to scale these solutions, connecting climate ambition to real lives.”

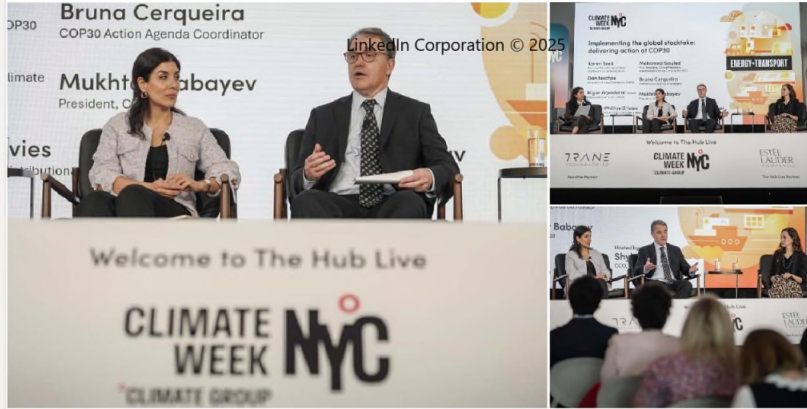

Day 1 at UNGA / NY Climate Week: From Ambition to Acceleration

The United Nations General Assembly in New York provides a unique platform for the full climate ecosystem to advance dialogues and collective solutions on the world's most pressing challenges. For the COP30 Brazil Presidency, it is a pivotal moment to catalyze climate action, accelerate implementation and build momentum on the road to Belém.

The Presidency kicked off the week by engaging in impactful events and productive discussions to accelerate collective climate action and build a safer, more prosperous future for all.

Today's events included:

Opening Climate Week NYC

President-Designate Amb. André Corrêa do Lago took the stage alongside Simon Stiell for the opening ceremony at #ClimateWeekNYC, setting the tone at one of the week's flagship events. They discussed COP30's action-centric approach to implementing the goals of the Paris Agreement by bringing climate action closer to people's lives.

Global Renewables Summit

Amb. Corrêa do Lago joined European-commission President Ursula von der Leyen, President of Kenya William Ruto, Prime Minister of the Bahamas Philip Edward Davis MP KC and Fortescue CEO Andrew Forrest to discuss opportunities to accelerate the global clean energy transition.

Solutions Dialogues

In the first four of ten convenings the Presidency will participate in during the week, cross-sector groups of leaders advanced plans to deliver solutions on:

Tackling extreme heat ("Beat the Heat"), where Ana Toni and UN Environment Programme called for cities, states and nations to join the #GlobalMutirão against extreme heat.

Accelerating Adaptation Implementation and Investment



Agreement. These included:

- Climate-resilient social protection and smallholder agriculture finance
- Strengthening multilevel governance for coordinated climate action
- Integrated Fire Management and Wildfire Resilience Center
- Leadership and Accelerating Food Systems Transformation

■ Bilateral & Stakeholder Meetings

The Presidency participated in additional sessions throughout the day on just transition, oceans, renewables and energy security, resilience, technology, sustainable heating and cooling, tipping points and global governance, all reinforcing COP30's priorities.

Tropical forests regulate the global climate, protect biodiversity, provide freshwater and sustain billions of people. Humanity depends on them.

To secure their future, Brazil presented the concept of the **Tropical Forest Forever Facility - TFFF** at COP28 – an idea that has since sparked wide discussions on the road to Belém, where the Facility is set to be formally launched.

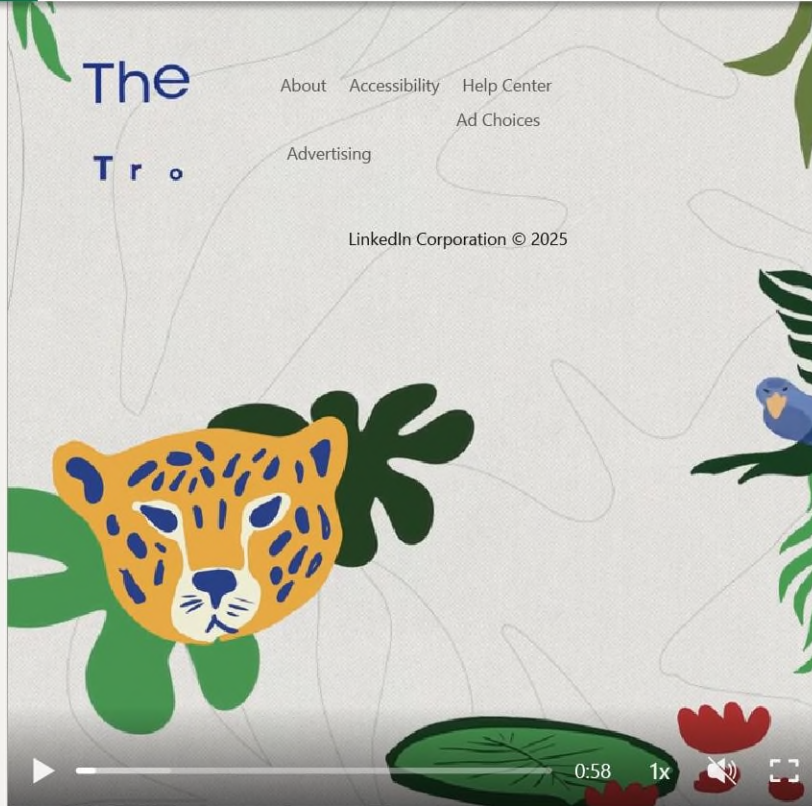
Its functioning can be transformative:

- 🔗 Conservation financing: Creates a predictable mechanism that rewards developing countries for keeping their tropical forests standing.
- Sustainable development: Links conservation to financial benefits, fostering community forestry, ecosystem services and green economic opportunities.
- Community support: Ensures that at least 20% of the funds a country receives go directly to Indigenous peoples and local communities.
- 🌳 Forest protection: Safeguards tropical forests from deforestation and degradation through satellite monitoring and performance-based payments.

When successfully implemented, TFFF will mark a paradigm shift in forest conservation - an integrated approach that unites economy and ecology, built through diplomacy and strengthened multilateralism.

At the opening ceremony of [Africa Climate Summit 2](#) that happened this last Monday, COP30 President-Designate Ambassador André Corrêa do Lago reaffirmed that Africa's collaboration and leadership will be central to [COP30 Brazil](#).

During his speech, he stressed three priorities that connect directly to people's lives:

- Ensuring that mitigation, adaptation, finance, technology, and capacity-building move forward together.
- Strengthening innovative finance through mechanisms like the Tropical Forests Forever Facility (TFFF), which will reward countries for their conservation of standing forests.
- Driving the Baku to Belém Roadmap to reform climate finance, scale adaptation, and deliver on the Global Stocktake.

Africa, as Ambassador Corrêa do Lago highlighted, is not simply a victim of climate change, but also a provider of solutions - from Ethiopia's 50-billion-tree Green Legacy Initiative to clean energy transitions already underway.

Together, Africa and Brazil can deliver concrete answers to the climate crisis.
