Dear Mr. Weniger:

This letter will confirm my conversation with Debra Kurtz regarding Gold and Liebengood's representation of Medela, Inc., on matters relating to the WIC program.

For the period of December, 1993 and January, 1994, this firm will provide legislative representation to your company. Such representation will include strategy counsel, contacts with certain Congressional offices, and potential contacts with pertinent Executive Branch officials.

For such services, Gold and Liebengood will be compensated at a rate of \$5,000 per month, with month of December being prorated at \$2,500. These fees are exclusive of reimbursable expenses. We will limit such expenses to long distance telephone charges, local transportation and messenger services, unless we seek and receive explicit authorization from Medela for additional expenses. There will be a one time pass through for filing charges imposed upon us by the U.S. Department of Justice to conform with the requirements of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. This will be included in our first invoice.


In the event that the situation surrounding the WIC program requires representation beyond the term contemplated in this letter, we will separately conclude another negotiation.
