

Dear Mr. Chang:

At the request of Mr. Robert Kahen, I am writing to confirm acceptance of terms to represent San Fu Chemical Company in the matter of H.R. 2313, a bill to extend for an additional 3 years the existing suspension of duty on p - Hydroxybenzoic acid (PHBA).

I have been informed by Mr. Kahen that the terms are \$5,000, to be paid in monthly installments of \$1,000 each during the next five months, and \$3,000 at the close of this session of Congress, provided we are successful in our goal of preventing H.R. 2313 from becoming law. The above-mentioned \$3,000 will not be paid if H.R. 2313 becomes law.


This agreement covers work for the remainder of 1986, that is, to the end of the current session of Congress. In 1987, a new Congress will take office. It is possible that this bill, may be introduced in the new Congress, even if it has been defeated in the previous Congress. If this should occur, I will consult with you to determine if you desire representation in 1987.

We will begin as soon as I receive telex or letter from you authorizing Paul Suplizio Associates to represent you. Early reply is requested, as the Congress will begin considering trade legislation in March.
