

Privacy Act Statement. 

Dear Ms. Blyth:

This letter will constitute a contractual agreement between London Docklands Development Corporation (LDDC) and GCI Group Inc. LDDC agrees to retain GCI Group Inc. for public relations services for the period August - October 1995 in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions.

It is agreed that the agency's fee will not exceed U.S. \$ 22,000, inclusive of routine out-of-pocket expenses, unless approved by you in advance. In consideration of the services to be performed by us, you will compensate us in accordance with the following:

For the period August 1 - 31, 1995 (payable upon agreement):	\$5,000
For the period September 1 - 30, 1995	\$ 9,000
For the period October 1 - 31, 1995	\$ 5,000

The public relations fee includes counseling on strategic messages related to LDDC, preparation of communications materials for use with the trade, business and consumer media, media placements, and handling of press inquiries, as outlined in the attached document submitted on August 22, 1995.

In addition, you agree to reimburse GCI Group Inc. for responsible out-of-pocket expenses incurred in implementing the public relations program such as phone, fax, xerox, postage, messenger and local transportation expenses in support of the program. These expenses will be billed at cost as incurred. Additional expenses of any significant amount will not be incurred without your prior approval.

Recognizing the competitive nature of LDDC's business, GCI Group Inc. will maintain confidentiality about LDDC's procedures and activities and will not disclose any materials prepared for or by LDDC without the client's permission.


