

SUBJECT: Consulting Contract
September 1, 1993 to August 31, 1994

We are very pleased that we are able to initiate a consulting relationship into 1994 which will continue your relationship with Gary Wasserman. We look forward to working closely with you in the future.

This document, when countersigned by you, will constitute the agreement between the Board of Foreign Trade, Ministry of Economic Affairs (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and Robinson, Lake, Lerer & Montgomery/Sawyer Miller Group (hereinafter referred to as "RL/SM") for reporting and informational services.

1. RL/SM will provide information, analysis and advice on likely developments in American economic, trade and political matters which are of interest to the Board.
2. RL/SM will recommend informational activities (briefings, visits, seminars, press releases, etc.) that will most effectively respond to these developments.
3. RL/SM will provide both oral and written briefings throughout the year on a regular basis and as requested by the Board.
4. In consideration of the aforementioned services provided to the Board by RL/SM, the Board agrees to pay RL/SM a fee of \$5,000.00 per month, payable at the beginning of each month, plus reasonable out-of-pocket expenses, not to exceed \$10,000.00 for the year (including, but not limited to, such items as travel, food and lodging, postage, copying, courier, computer and research).

5. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 1993, through August 31, 1994. The parties may agree to negotiate a new contract prior to the termination of this one.
6. All information provided to the Board by us during the course of this contract shall be for the use of the Board itself, and shall not be made public without the express consent of RL/SM.
7. This agreement may be terminated by either the Board or RL/SM upon 90 days written notice to the other.

If the foregoing reflects your understanding of our agreement, I would appreciate your signing both copies of this letter where indicated and returning one to me. Please keep the other for your files.

Once again, my colleagues and I are very pleased to have the opportunity to work with you on this project.
