**Activities During the 6 month reporting period**

**SABIC Petrochemicals:** Weber Shandwick provided strategic counsel on target markets in industrial sectors in which SABIC offers products for sale. Weber Shandwick's work consisted of media monitoring, writing and distributing press releases and building media relationships. Weber Shandwick's work is limited to publicizing the company and its products to United States markets and companies that might purchase SABIC products by encouraging press coverage of SABIC products and capabilities with media organizations through press releases and other activities. Weber Shandwick's work does not involve any contacts intended to directly or indirectly influence any legislation or policy of the United States government. Weber Shandwick does not directly or indirectly contact any United States government officials on behalf of SABIC for the purpose of influencing legislation or government policy. Weber Shandwick's services are solely to advance the business interests of SABIC in United States markets for which SABIC can supply products and services.

**Temasek Holdings:** Weber Shandwick provided daily media monitoring services, coverage of major announcements and monitoring of developments at key U.S. government agencies and congressional committees. Weber Shandwick's work for Temasek is focused on its investment activities in the United States, and the Washington monitoring activities relate to Temasek's existing or future investments in the United States. Weber Shandwick is not engaged to influence any U.S. legislation or government policy.

**Fundo Mixto de Promocion Turistica del Distrito Federal:** Weber Shandwick has been retained by Mexico City to promote Mexico City as a tourist destination. Weber Shandwick has developed and executed a public relations campaign that consisted of the following elements:

- Arranging for Mexico City to sponsor a booth at the 2014 New York City Wine & Food Festival and seeking and obtaining coverage of the booth in traditional and digital media. The booth provided festival attendees an opportunity to sample cuisine from top Mexico City chefs.
- Promoting the Catina MX Fest, which took place in Mexico City on November 1, 2014.
- Arranging press trips for reporters to Mexico City.
- Promoting the fact that Mexico City was named the No. 3 most Inspiring City in the World on the GOOD City Index.
- Contacting reporters and responding to media inquiries in the United States to promote Mexico City as a tourist destination and providing a press kit and fact sheets.
- Media monitoring and compiling a media summary of stories about Mexico City.

None of this work involves directly or indirectly influencing United States Government legislation or policy.
