

This liaison effort includes attending hearings on Capitol Hill, attending meetings with groups interested in national security and NATO cooperation, as well as providing information with respect to our client's capabilities. Payment

- a) Fees. ROBISON INTERNATIONAL shall be paid a monthly fee of \$ 7.000 each month for the term of the contract. Payment shall be made by check or electronic transfer to be credited to ROBISON INTERNATIONAL's bank account no later than the 5th of the applicable month.
- b) Expenses. The monthly fee shall include all reasonable expenses incurred by ROBISON INTERNATIONAL in the execution of the firm's services. Reasonable expenses are defined to include normal administrative charges such as bookkeeping, telephone calls, entertainment as permitted by law, office charges and equipment, and general transport costs in the local area (Washington, D.C.). The following costs are not included in the fee:

1. Travel overseas
2. Transcontinental U.S. travel

If any costs are to be incurred in these or other areas cost projections will be submitted for approval prior to incurring such costs.

Term

This arrangement is to extend from 6 September 1986 until 30 September 1987, with an automatic renewal thereafter unless either party gives 60 days notice of its desire to terminate or modify the agreement.

Liability


It is understood that ROBISON INTERNATIONAL will not be responsible for the accuracy of facts supplied to it by EUROMISSILE, or factual matters included in the material prepared by ROBISON INTERNATIONAL and approved by EUROMISSILE. EUROMISSILE agrees to (1) indemnify and hold harmless ROBISON INTERNATIONAL, INC from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, expense, or liabilities (collectively "costs") which ROBISON INTERNATIONAL may
