

Aerospatiale Helicopter Corporation is owned, through a voting trust established for FAA purposes, by Aerospatiale, a French government-owned company engaged in the design, development, production and sale of civil and military aircraft, helicopters, tactical missiles, ballistic and space systems and the provision of related support services.

Aerospatiale is a government-owned company with 74.96% of its capital shares held directly by the French Republic and 25% held indirectly through a state agency. The remainder of Aerospatiale's capital shares (0.04%) are primarily held by government-owned French banks.


