



CONSULTING AGREEMENT

CONSULTING AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), dated as of March 15, 1993, between Crowell & Moring International L.P. ("Consultant"), doing business as "C&M International, Ltd.", a Delaware limited partnership having offices at 1001 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, #1275, Washington, DC 20004, and the Fishing Industry Inspection and Certification Council (FIIICC) of New Zealand ("Client"), having offices at Fishing Industry House, 73-75 Cambridge Terrace, Private Bag, Manners Street, Wellington, New Zealand.

I. Retention. Client hereby engages Consultant, and Consultant hereby accepts such engagement to provide consulting services as set forth in this Agreement.

II. Services. Consultant will provide the following services to Client:

A. Consulting services and assistance with the formulation and negotiation of a food safety agreement between the responsible authorities of the Government of the United States and the Government of New Zealand, in a timely manner; and,

B. Assistance with the formulation, development of support for, and presentation of positions relating to the nature, criteria, standards of evaluation, and scope of the food safety agreement.

III. Fees and Expenses.

A. Client shall pay Consultant a fee of US\$ 15,000 for the services described in Paragraph II.

B. Client shall reimburse Consultant for expenses incurred on behalf of Client (including travel, telephone, fax, postage, word processing, photocopying and administrative overtime) upon receipt of Consultant's invoices for such expenses.

IV. Term.

The term of this agreement shall be March 15, 1993 to October 1, 1993. Either party may terminate this Agreement on seven days written notice to the other, provided that Client shall pay fees and expenses of Consultant through the date of termination.

V. Relationship.

A. In representing Client, Consultant shall not be barred from representing Client's individual members or from representing other entities whose interests are adverse to those of Client's individual members. The parties have entered into this Agreement as independent contractors, and

no principal-agent or other relationship is created hereby. Each party is authorized to disclose this Agreement as such party may deem necessary or appropriate to comply with applicable laws, rules or governmental orders.


B. Consultant hereby agrees for itself, and on behalf of its officers, directors, employees and agents, that it will take appropriate steps consistent with U.S. law to maintain the confidentiality of Client's non-public information provided it is in connection with the performance of service under this Agreement.

VI. Governing Law.

The terms and provisions of this Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with, and governed by, the laws of the District of Columbia and the United States of America.
